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COVID-19 VULNERABLE EXEMPTION FORM

The Governor’s Phase Two Directive allows for utility disconnect exemptions for individuals who are defined as vulnerable and are still sheltering at home. However, the vulnerable individuals must also currently be “suffering a significant financial hardship as a result of the outbreak” to benefit from the protection from utility shutoff and suspension of late fees.

Vulnerable Definition: “People over 65 years of age, people with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, or asthma, and people whose immune system is compromised such as by chemotherapy for cancer or other conditions requiring such therapy.”
