

RESOLUTION NO. 436

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE, MONTANA,
TO VACATE THE 40-FOOT ALLEY RUNNING THROUGH BLOCK 17, LOTS 3 THROUGH 18, OF THE
ORIGINAL TOWNSITE OF STEVENSVILLE**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, Ravalli County, Montana did on 6th day of September, 2018 receive a petition, signed by property owners of Block 17, Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 of the Original Townsite of Stevensville, a platted subdivision of Ravalli County, Montana, to vacate the 40-foot alley, and;

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2018, the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, approved Resolution 433, a Resolution declaring the intent to vacate the 40-foot Alley running through Block 17, Lots 3 through 18, of the original Townsite of Stevensville;


WHEREAS, a majority of the property owners requested this closure;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville hereby declares intent to vacate the 40-foot alley in Block 17, Lots 3 through 18 of the Original Townsite of Stevensville to be permanently closed, returning 20 feet to each of the property owners of the lots involved.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any utility easements and access that may be presently recorded will be retained.
