RESOLUTION NO. 367

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CREATE TWIN CREEKS LIGHTING DISTRICT FOR THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE

WHEREAS, the Town of Stevensville has required that the developer of the Twin Creeks Subdivision include a lighting district as a condition of subdivision approval;

WHEREAS, the Town Council previously approved the plan for street lighting for the Twin Creeks subdivision;

NOW,THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council for the Town of Stevensville hereby files its Notice of Intention to Create the Twin Creeks Lighting District within the boundaries of Phase I of the Twin Creeks Subdivision. These lands are located in Section 35, T9N, R20W, P.M.M. Ravalli County, Montana; and

- 1. The Twin Creeks Lighting District shall include all Lots within Phase I of the Twin Creeks subdivision; and
- 2. Said Lighting District shall be known as Twin Creeks Lighting District in the Town of Stevensville; and
- 3. The installation and capital improvements included wires, pipes, conduits, lamps and other suitable and necessary materials and labor costs with the cost of installation and labor at \$25,422.67; and
- 4. The estimated administrative charge of \$2,000.00 reasonably corresponds to the legal fees incurred by the Town to create a lighting district and for the administrative costs for assessments and monthly accounting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that written protest against the proposed work or against the extent or creation of the district to be assessed may be submitted to the clerk of the Town at any time within 15 days after the first publication of this notice. Notice of Resolution of Intent to Create the Twin Creeks Lighting District shall set hearing on any written protests to the Resolution of Intention for Twin Creeks Lighting District at 6.30 p.m. on the 40 day of 2015.
