RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-13 BUDGET PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the Town of Stevensville, Montana, adopted the budget for the Fiscal year of 2012-13 by Resolution No. 294; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Stevensville, Montana, has determined that there is an unexpected and immediate need to replace a police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Stevensville, Montana, in the 2006-2010 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) recognized the purchase of a vehicle as a legitimate capital expense; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Stevensville, Montana has set aside \$319,000.00 in a savings account ending in ...1811, to fund CIP expenses; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 7-6-4006, MCA, the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, Montana has held a public hearing on the proposed fiscal year 2012-13 budget amendment providing for \$35,000.00 transfer to fund # 4000-101000 general fund CIP account as required by law; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, that the amount of **THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000)** be transferred from the savings account ending in ... 1811 to Fund # 4000-101000 (CIP Operating Cash Fund), for the purchase of a police vehicle.
