RESOLUTION No. 271-A

A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE THE TRANSIENT MERCHANT BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIREMENT FOR VENDORS AT THE WESTERN HERITAGE DAYS AND CREAMERY PICNIC

Whereas the Town Council has previously adopted an ordinance, codified at Section 5.08 of the Stevensville Municipal Code, requiring that all transient merchants obtain a business license from the Town of Stevensville;

Whereas certain special events that occur once a year commonly have various vendors that offer goods and services to the attendees at these special events;

Whereas the vast majority of vendors only attend one, or a small number, of special events each year and do not regularly offer or provide transient merchant goods or services;

Whereas, the Town of Stevensville believes it is in the Town's best interests to allow the organizers of the respective special events to regulate and supervise any and all vendors they allow to attend their special event;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Stevensville Town Council hereby waives the requirement that vendors obtain transient merchant licenses for special events listed below. Any vendors approved and allowed by the organizers of the special event to attend their special event shall not be required by the Town of Stevensville to obtain a transient merchant business license. This waiver applies to the following special events:

- 1. Western Heritage Days, to be held on June 22nd and 23rd, 2012 and
- 2. The Creamery Picnic, to be held on August 3rd 5th, 2012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this waiver only applies to the two special events listed above, and this waiver shall only apply for the year 2012.
