

RESOLUTION #260

A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND TEMPORARY ORDINANCE NO. 103 FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR.

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2010, the Town Council did adopt Ordinance No. 103, an Interim zoning ordinance of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, imposing restrictions upon the opening, operation and location of any establishment that grows, sells or distributes medical marijuana and directing the study of new proposed ordinances to regulate such establishments, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance, as per section 76-2-306 MCA is only in effect for six (6) months from the date of adoption, and


WHEREAS, there has been insufficient time for the Planning and Zoning Committee to develop the necessary regulations, and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that the 2011 session of the Montana State Legislature will, in all likelihood, be making substantial changes in the State Statutes regulating medical marijuana which will need to be a part of any local regulations,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the above temporary ordinance no. 103 is hereby extended for a period of one year, as provided for in section 76-2-306 MCA and shall be effect immediately upon passage.
