
WHEREAS, all citizens and property within the Town of Stevensville are at risk from a wide range of hazards, such as, but not limited to, flooding, earthquakes, winter storms, wind and thunderstorms, wildfire, landslides, and volcanic hazards.

WHEREAS, the Town, pursuant to Section 322, Mitigation Planning, of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, enacted by Section 104 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-390) and the Interim Final Rule published in the Federal Registry on February 26, 2002 at 44 CFR Part 201, is required to have an approved Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to receive future federal disaster mitigation funds.


WHEREAS, a Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan will guide the Town in making decisions for pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation projects.

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
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
