## RESOLUTION NO. 191

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE STEVENSVILLE DEVELOPMENT CODE

WHEREAS, The Stevensville Town Council directed the Planning and Zoning Board to prepare a recommendation providing for significant amendments to the zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board identified numerous sections of the zoning code that were out of date, and identified areas of concern that were not addressed in the zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board held numerous public meetings to discuss development issues of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board held a public hearing on the proposed changes on October 1, 2002, and then transmitted its recommendation to the Town Council on that same date; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council reviewed the Planning and Zoning Board's recommendation on October 15, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council directed that minor amendments be made to the Development Code as a result of comments at said public hearing; and

WHEREAS, all amendments have been incorporated into the final Amended Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council intends to update the Development Code from time to time as circumstances change.

NOW THEREFORE, THE STEVENSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
