

RESOLUTION NO. 99

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE REGULATION AND LICENSING OF GAMES OF CHANCE AND CERTAIN CARD GAMES: PROVIDING FOR UNIFORM LICENSING OF ELECTRONIC GAMBLIT DEVICES AND PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS OF OPERATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Montana Card Games, Bingo, Raffles & Electronic Poker Machine Act, the Town of Stevensville had enacted regulations contrrolling the operation and licensing of such games of chance; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Montana has amended the provision of the gambling statutes, reducing the licensing fees to be assessed by local governments; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Stevensville deem it in the public interest to exercise the authority delegated in the acts and revise the regulations and licensing provisions; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Stevensville find that an emergency exists because the State gambling laws are now effective and because gambling is being carried on within the Town of Stevensville;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE, RAVALLI COUNTY, MONTANA:

1. Any person who has obtained a license from the Montana Department of Revenue for the operation of video draw poker, Keno or bingo machines may obtain a license from the Town Clerk for the operation of that machine within the Town of Stevensville for the sum of One hundred and no/00 Dollars (\$100.00) for each machine so licensed.
2. The premises upon which the machines are located may be open to the public for the use of such machines 24 hours per day; EXCEPTING that premises where alcoholic beverages are dispensed are subject to such limitations as may be set forth by the Montana Liquor Control Board.
3. The gambling regulations of the Town of Stevensville are hereby amended as set forth herein.

4. The effective date of this amendment shall be July 1, 1987.
