RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF APPLICATION WITH THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR A PUBLIC WORKS GRANT FOR "INDUSTRIAL FACILITY AND RELATED MUNICIPAL WATER IMPROVEMENTS."

WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Works Grants, the Economic Development Administration is authorized to make grants to Public bodies to aid in financing specific projects:

That the above named authorized representative is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Economic Development Administration, may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed, and further is authorized to accept any offer of grant which may be tendered by the Economic Development Administration.
