


RESOLUTION NO. 94

WHEREAS, THE Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, Ravalli County, Montana, did on the 22nd day of September 1986, receive a petition from 13 property owners in Blocks 4, 5, 17, 18, 19 20, 28 and 29 of the original townsite of the Town of Stevensville, petitioning the Town Council to reduce the 100 foot Mission Street to a 60 foot street, returning to the property owners 20 feet of property.

WHEREAS, The Town Council of the Town of Stevensville did publish notice stating that the petition would be acted on and public comment would be taken on October 13th, 1986 at 7:30 p.m., in Council Chambers. Said hearing was held and there being no opposition to said act of reducing the Mission Street to a 60 foot street and transferring 20 feet of right of way back to property owners:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville that Mission Street between 1st Street and North Avenue be reduced from the present 100 feet to 60 feet, returning 20 feet of property to the owners as herein described: Lots 1 thru 7, Block 4, Lots 10 thru 17, Block 5, Lots 11 thru 20, Block 17, Lots 1 thru 10, Block 18, Lots 1 thru 10, Block 19, Lots 11 thru 20, Block 20, Lots 3,4,5, Block 28 and Lots 1,2,3 and 4, Block 29, all in the original townsite of the Town of Stevensville.
