

RESOLUTION NO. 86

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE COUNCIL FOR THE CREATION OF AN AIRPORT ADVISORY BOARD, AND FOR THE DESIGANTION OF THE POWERS AND DUTIES FOR THE ADVISORY BOARD AND THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, The Town Council of the Town of Stevensville has assumed ownership and juristicition over the Stevensville Airport by deed and resolution No. 243 of the Ravalli County Commissioners, as recorded in Book 154 of Deeds on Page 861 of the records of the County of Ravalli, State of Montana, and,

WHEREAS, TO more fully acquaint the Stevensville Town Council with Airport needs for the Community and assist in the Mangement of the Airport under the jurisdiction of the Town, it is to the interest of Citizens of the Town that a Board of intersted citizens of the Town be created, to advise the Town Council as to needs of the airport and for recommendations of magement thereof. This board shall be know as the Stevensville Airport Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a Board of Citizens, consisting of four persons be, and the same is hereby created to advise the Stevensville Town Council as to the needs of the Community for Airport facilities and the proper use thereof, and to assist in the mangement of the same under the authority of the Town Council of Stevensville.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the board shall consist of four members, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Council, two members who are residents of the Town, one member from the Out of Town area and one Council member. each member shall be appointed for a term of three years, excepting that one member of the initial board shall be appointed for a term of one year, two members for a term of two years and one for a term of three years. All members of the board shall be at least 19 years of age.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the advisory board shall have no policy making powers, the same being reserved to the Stevensville Town Council, but shall be empowered to investigate and make recommendations of policy to said Council, The Town Council shall, from time to time provide in writing, guidelines under which the advisory board shall act.
