

RESOLUTION NO. 82

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR LAND AND WATER
CONSERVATION FUND ASSISTANCE FOR DEVELOPMENT OF FATHER
RAVALLI PARK, TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE

WHEREAS, THE Town of Stevensville is interested in interested in developing outdoor recreational facilities on a 1.94 acre tract of land, designated as park area in the Dayton Addition to the Town of Stevensville for the citizenry of the Town of Stevensville, Ravalli County, Montana: At an estimated cost of \$10,000 in materials

AND, Land and Water conservation Fund financial assistance is required for the development of said outdoor recreational facilities,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville that the project described above be authorized,

AND, be it further resolved by the Stevensville Town Council that application to the Parks Division to seek Land and Water Conservation Fund financial assistance from the National Park Service in the amount of \$5,000.00 or 50% of the actual cost of the project in behalf of said TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE.

AND, be it further resolved by the Stevensville Town Council that it certifies to the following:

1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in the Land and Water Conservation Fund Grants-in-aid Manual and the official agreement between the applicant and the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks, both of which will be part of the project agreement for any grant awarded.
2. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the development in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks.
3. That it has, at the time of application, its share of the costs of the project and will initiate work within 90 days of project approval.
4. That the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Town of Stevensville for public outdoor recreational use.
5. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for cost sharing.
6. That open public participation was encouraged throughout the planning phases of the project.
