

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION:

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, on the 28th day of March 1983, the petition signed by 90% of the freeholders of the proposed Improvement District to be formed within the limits of the Town of Stevensville, which petition requests formation of said improvement district; and

WHEREAS, The Town Council has examined the petition and found the petition to be in all respects, proper:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the said improvement district shall be designated as Stevensville Improvement District No. 3.

2. That the boundaries of the said district are described as follows:

Lots 1 through 17 of the Dickerson Tract; and lot 10, block 6, and Lot 1, Block 7, Dobbins addition to the Town of Stevensville. 6th Street, east of the intersection with College street .

3. The character of the improvements to be made are as follows:

Surface preparation, compaction, manhole adjustments, a 24 foot asphalt pavement driving lane with a 24 foot crushed cushion rock on parking lanes on each side of pavement.

4. S & A Engineers of Helena, Montana, are hereby designated as engineers in charge of said district.

5. The improvements described are estimated at a cost of \$28,186, with the cost to be assessed in equal amounts to each of the 19 owners involved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That 25th day of April 1983, at the Council Chambers at the hour of 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the regular business of the Council can be conducted is the time and place set for the hearing of protests against such district or withdrawal from the petition of any of the owners, the same having been signed by 90% of the owners thereof.

The Clerk of the council was directed to provide notice in accordance with the statutes of the State of Montana. All protests will be in writing and delivered to the Town Clerk.
