

RESOLUTION NO. 60

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT CO-OWNERSHIP
OF CERTAIN PROPERTY

WHEREAS, THE Burnt Fork Local #37 of the Farmers Union has offered to sell to the Town of Stevensville and the Fort Owen Post #94 of the American Legion property described as follows:

A tract of land in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, Township 9 North, Range 19W, M.M., designated as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of said Sec. 29, thence North 264.0 feet; thence East 247.5 feet; thence South 264.0 feet; thence West 247.5 feet to the place of beginning, containing $1\frac{1}{4}$ acres more or less.

for the sum of \$1.00.

AND WHEREAS, The terms and conditions of co-ownership are that the Fort Owen Post #94 American Legion will manage the property for Legion and Community Activities for so long as the post exists and in the event the post should become in-active, the Town through it's Town Council will operate the property as a Community Activity Center.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Town of Stevensville enter into a co-ownership agreement with Fort Owen Post #94 American Legion for the property described above and that the Mayor and Town Clerk are authorized to sign all documents pertaining to this land purchase.
