

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION:

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Town Council of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, on the 23rd day of February, 1981, the petition of 100% of the freeholders of the proposed Improvement District to be formed within the limits of the Town of Stevensville, which petition requesting petition of said improvement district; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has examined the petition and found the petition to be in all respects, proper:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That the said improvement district shall be designated as Stevensville Special Improvement District No. 2.
2. That the boundaries of the said district are described as follows:

Lots 9 through 14, Block 1; and Lots 3 through 12, Block 2, George A. Smith Subdivision, and Maplewood Cemetery of the Town of Stevensville.

3. The Character of the improvements to be made are as follows:

Surfacing of Barbara Street, including asphalt pavement and installation of curbs and gutters.

4. S & A Engineers of Helena, Montana, are hereby designated as engineers in charge of said district.

5. The improvements described are estimated to cost \$22.00 per lineal foot of the assessed land abutting on the street within the District. The cost of these improvements shall be assessed to the property owners within the District upon the lineal foot frontage of their lots in accordance with the statutes of the State of Montana.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that 23rd day of March, 1981, at the Council Chambers at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M. or as soon thereafter as the regular business of the Council can be completed, is the time and place set for the hearing of protests against said district or withdrawal from the petition of any of the owners, the same having been signed by 100% of the owners thereof.

The Clerk of the Council was directed to provide notice in accordance with the statutes of the State of Montana.

All protests will be in writing and delivered to the Town Clerk.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN:

That in accordance with petition filed with an presented to the Stevensville Town Council, the said Stevensville Town Council, on the 23rd day of February 1981, passed a Resolution of Intention to Create Special Improvement District #2, within the Town limits of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, consisting of Lots 9 through 14, Block 1; and Lots 3 through 12, Block 2, George A. Smith Subdivision, and Maplewood Cemetery, of the Town of Stevensville, on Barbara Street.

Such Resolution of Intention is on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Stevensville and is available for inspection by the public and reference is hereby made to it for a description of the boundaries of said District.

The general character of improvements to be made in said District is the Surfacing of Barbara Street, including asphalt pavement, and installation of curbs and gutters.

Protests may be in writing and filed with the Town Clerk. Such protests may be made by any person owning property liable for assessment for the cost of said improvements, and any such person may appear at the time and place herein designated and make themselves heard before the Town Council.
