

RESOLUTION NO. 55

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE FORMATION OF A SPECIAL LIGHTING DISTRICT IN BLOCKS 1, 2 and 3 of THE LEE DAYTON ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE, RAVALLI COUNTY, MONTANA.

WHEREAS, A majority of the property owners within the proposed district have petitioned the Town Council for creation of a Special Lighting District for Blocks 1, 2 and 3 of the Lee Dayton Addition, for the installation, by Montana Power Company, of eleven (11), 175 Watt mercury vapor, post top lights, mounted at approximately 17 feet on steel poles, with underground wiring;

WHEREAS, The estimated annual cost will be \$1,275.00, plus administrative costs, and the estimated annual assessment to the property owners will be \$30.00 per year or \$2.50 per month, to be billed with property taxes;


WHEREAS, The Stevensville Town Council passed a resolution of intention to create said Special Lighting District on May 12, 1980, with 15 days for written protests to be heard, and no such protests were received;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and The Council of the Town of Stevensville that a majority of the property owners so desire and the Town hereby creates a Special Lighting District for Blocks 1, 2 and 3 of the Lee Dayton Addition to the Town of Stevensville, Ravalli County, Montana, to be known as Special Lighting District #2.
