

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE FEES FOR BUILDING PERMITS WITHIN THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE, RAVALLI COUNTY, MONTANA; providing FOR APPLICATION FOR SAID BUILDING PERMIT AND SETTING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE, MONTANA

SECTION 1. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to build within the Town limits of the Town of Stevensville must first apply to the Town Clerk for a building permit. They must furnish the Clerk with a drawing of the desired building, stating the size, number of rooms, location on lots, description of lots and block of Town property, which drawing becomes the property of the Town. In the event the Clerk feels that Council action should be taken on a building, he or she has the right to refuse the permit until the council has given approval at a regularly convened meeting of said Town Council.

SECTION 2. Permit fees shall be as follows: For residential or business buildings the fee shall be four cents (4¢) per square foot: For outside buildings such as garages, storage buildings the fee shall be two cents per square foot (2¢). A minimum fee of \$5 shall be charged on all or any outside buildings.

SECTION 3. All building will be done in accordance to Zoning Committee rules and regulations and any violation of any section of this resolution shall be subject to a fine not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00; and each day or occasion upon which any act or condition hereby prohibited shall be done, exist or continue, shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. The Stevensville Town Council hereby declare that an emergency exists and that this resolution is to be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
