

the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of and taxpayers on property within the Town of Stevensville, the question of issuing bonds upon the faith and credit of the Town of Stevensville, in the sum of \$125,000.00; that such amount of indebtedness, if incurred, will exceed the constitutional limit of five per cent (5%) of the value of the taxable property within the Town of Stevensville, ascertained by the last assessment for state and county taxes, but will not exceed the additional 10% of such value authorized for the procuring of sanitary sewage system and plant for treatment or disposal of sewage for such municipality. The said sum of \$125,000.00 is to be used in the construction, reconstruction and extension of existing sanitary sewage system and for treatment and disposal of sewage therefrom from the Town of Stevensville.

AND BE IT RESOLVED, that the 10th day of May, 1977, be and the same is hereby designated as the day the said election shall be held in the Town of Stevensville, the same being the day for special Town bond election and that the polls be open between the hours of twelve o'clock Noon and eight o'clock P.M. on said day.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Town of Stevensville, order and secure from the Clerk and Recorder for Ravalli County, a complete list of all qualified electors of the Town of Stevensville, and that the said Clerk is further instructed to give notice of said special election as provided by law.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be, and she is hereby instructed to prepare all necessary ballots, books and election booths, and that the necessary election judges and clerks be appointed to conduct the said special bond election.
