

RESOLUTION NO. 13

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT POSSESSION OR TRANSPORTING OF UNSEALED CONTAINERS OR PACKAGES CONTAINING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES IN THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE.

WHEREAS, it is offensive to members of the public and detrimental to the morals of minors within the Town of Stevensville to permit the consumption or display of unsealed packages or containers of alcoholic beverages on the streets, sidewalks or other buildings within the Town not licensed to permit such consumption or display;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stevensville Town Council that the following ordinance be adopted and included in the Municipal Code of Stevensville:

Chapter 9.32

Prohibiting the display of alcoholic beverages and offensive merchandise.

Sections: 9.32.010

From and after the enactment and publication of this ordinance, EXCEPT AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED, it shall be unlawful for any person to consume, display or carry an unsealed can, bottle, glass or other package or container containing any alcoholic beverage on the sidewalks, streets or public buildings within the Town of Stevensville: Provided that nothing herein contained shall prohibit a fireman or any members of a law enforcement agency from removing opened containers from a building in the course of performing his duties.

Any person violating the provision of this chapter for which another penalty has not been provided, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished as set forth in Section 1.16020.
