RESOLUTION APPOINTING AGENT TO ACT FOR THE TOWN OF STEVENSVILLE PURSUANT TO APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ADMINISTRATION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, (33USC466 ET SEQ)

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Water Pollution Control Act (33USC 466 ET SEQ), the United States of America has authorized the making of grants to authorized applicants to aid in the construction of specific public projects, and the Town of Stevensville has made application therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stevensville Town Council that Delos Dickerson is hereby appointed agent to act on behalf of the Town of Stevensville and the Stevensville Town Council and is hereby authorized to execute and file any and all applications on behalf of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, with the United States Government for a grant to aid in the construction of upgrade treatment facilities and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration may reasonably request in connection with such application and to sign all necessary documents and receive payment for and on behalf of the said Town of Stevensville.
