

RESOLUTION NO. 5

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City/Town of

Stevensville

Montana that they do hereby request and petition the Legislature of the State of Montana to amend HB #254 of Legislative Session of 1971 to establish that the total Municipal Gasoline Tax Allocation be divided into two equal portions and that one portion be allocated to incorporated Cities and Towns of Montana in accordance to their per centum of street and alley mileage total of Montana, and that the second portion be allocated to incorporated Cities and Towns of Montana in accordance to their individual per centum of gasoline tax revenue contribution (or generation) of the total Montana Municipal Gasoline Tax Revenue and that no incorporated Montana City or Town shall receive less than \$520/mile/year/\$1,800,00 total Municipal Gasoline Tax Revenue, and be in further resolved that they do hereby request to petition that this amended legislation allow Cities and Towns to use their allocation amounts and interest or accumulated funds of this program for the purpose of interest-principal payments toward the retirement of street program bond expense.
