

RESOLUTION 2

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE FORMATION OF A SPECIAL STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT IN LOTS 4 THROUGH 26, INCLUSIVE, PETERSON ADDITION, STEVENSVILLE, RAVALLI COUNTY, MONTANA

WHEREAS, a majority of the property owners within the proposed district have petitioned for the creation of special street lighting district from the north edge of Lots 4 and 26 to the east edge of Lots 14 and 15, for the installation of eight (8) 175-watt mercury vapor post top type luminary to be installed by the Montana Power Company, and

WHEREAS, the estimated annual cost of said special lighting district will be the sum of \$476.16, plus administrative costs, and the estimated annual assessment to the property owners will be \$2.18 per thousand square feet of property owned;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Council of the Town of Stevensville, Montana, that notice be given to all property owners by publication in the Northwest Tribune, the official newspaper of the Town, of the time and place for hearing objections to the creation of such special street lighting district;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that objections shall be heard on the 5 day of November, 1973, at 8:00 P.M. in Council Chambers in the Town Hall, Stevensville, Montana;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon hearing objections, if a majority of the property owners within the said proposed district shall desire special street lighting district, the same shall be created.

PASSED by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
