

**PUBLIC HEARING
MEETING MINUTES
THURSDAY, MARCH 5th, 2015
6:30 p.m.**

The Stevensville Town Council came together for a public hearing at Town Council Chambers for the purpose of obtaining public comments regarding the community development needs and priorities of the Town of Stevensville for economic development, housing and community revitalization, and public facilities, and particularly as those needs affect low and moderate income persons.

The Town is considering submitting an application to the Montana Department of Commerce for a Community Development Block Grant – Economic Development Program (CDBG-ED) grant and wants to obtain public comment on the needs of the community.

Present were Councilperson Perrin, Councilperson Crews, Councilperson Holcomb, and Councilperson Hunter. Councilperson Perrin chaired the hearing due to Mayor Mim Mack being out of town. There were no members of the public present.

RCEDA Director Julie Foster gave a presentation on the 2015 CDBG programs, loan funds and grants.
